
CoSoSys updates My Endpoint Protector with cloud focus

AppleTell investigated the CoSoSys Data Loss Prevention (DLP) and Mobile Device Management (MDM) tools in the MacIT forum at this year's Macworld expo. The company recently announced an update to help businesses migrating their infrastructure to the cloud.

Cloudy with a chance of Business

Companies using My Endpoint Protector in a Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) format outpaced those opting for other installation methods, a fact CoSoSys attributes to the convenience of the cloud. Rather than worrying about keeping the tool itself up and running, cloud-based installations of the Endpoint Protector and MDM tools require less overhead management, which frees up IT admin resources. The updates to the tools are designed to help organization secure their data when it lives in cloud services like iCloud or Dropbox.



The list of updates includes new URL and Domain whitelisting, which permits users to transfer data to trusted websites and send data to trusted email addresses. There are also custom content filters with Regular Expressions, which give admins customizable rules to search for data. Sensitive data is usually pretty easy to recognize, such as 16-digit credit card numbers or the 3-2-4 patter of Social Security Numbers; with a customized rule you can search for your company's unique account number or other information to prevent its loss. A simplified interface also gives admins the option to authorize all devices from a particular brand, reducing the work it would take to authorize the use of multiple versions of iPhone and iPad, for example.
